If you live in one of the five eastern towns of Suffolk County, you can apply for a pistol license from the Pistol License Bureau. The bureau handles the investigation, issuance, and maintenance of all pistol licenses in this area. It also keeps track of over 6,000 active files, renewals, transactions, and correspondence. A pistol license is a state license that county officers grant. You need to choose the type of license you want. The most common types are: Possess on Premises: You can keep handguns in your home and use them for target shooting. You can also carry them to and from the range. Carry Concealed: You can carry a concealed handgun anywhere, as long as you follow state and federal laws. You need to complete a DCJS approved firearms training course with at least 16 hours of training and live-fire. Possess/Carry During Employment (for municipality): You can carry a concealed handgun while working for a state or local institution. You need to work in an armed role for a town, village, or municipality in the five eastern towns of Suffolk County. Eligibility Requirements: To get a pistol license, you must: Be a New York State resident. Be 21 years old. Reveal any mental illness history. Have no felony or serious offense convictions, and no Assault 3rd, Misdemeanor DWI, or Menacing 3rd convictions in the last five years. (This may include a felony arrest that was reduced to a misdemeanor charge.) Have the character, temperament, and judgement to handle a weapon safely and responsibly. Live or have a main residence in the five eastern towns of Suffolk County. Be an applicant who has no good reason to be denied a pistol license. Get four (4) Affidavit of Character References that are fully filled out and notarized by the reference. To apply: Contact the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office to get a copy of the pistol license application, instructions, and fees. If you want to apply for a New York State Pistol/Revolver License, you need to fill out an application form and provide some personal information. You can get the form and other documents from the Pistol License Bureau at the Riverhead Correctional Facility. The address and phone number are: Pistol License Bureau - Riverhead Correctional Facility 100 Center Drive South Riverhead, NY 11901 (631) 852-2233 The office is open from 9:00am to 4:30pm, and the fingerprinting service is available from 9:00am to 12:00pm. To complete the application form, you need to write your: - Full name - Date of birth - Social security number - Address - Physical description - Criminal history - Mental health history - Character references You also need to show your identification, which can be either a current New York driver's license or a non-driver's ID from the Department of Motor Vehicles. Make sure you use black ink only to fill out the form. When you have completed the form and gathered all the required documents, you need to bring them in person to the Pistol License Bureau. You also need to pay some fees and bring some photos. The fees are: - Application fee: \$10.00 (cash or check) - Fingerprint processing fee: \$88.25 (money order only payable to the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office) The photos are: - Two passport-style photos taken within 30 days (no polaroid's or home photos) You also need to show your: - NYS driver's license with your address in one of the five eastern towns - Birth certificate or current U.S. passport The five eastern towns are Riverhead, East Hampton, Shelter Island, Southampton, and Southold. If you live in one of the other five towns (Babylon, Brookhaven, Huntington, Islip, or Smithtown), you need to contact the Suffolk County Police Department at (631) 852-6311 or visit their website. Please remember that you can only submit your application and get fingerprinted from 9:00am to 12:00pm, Monday to Friday. Also, please be aware of this important safety notice: If a pistol license holder dies, becomes seriously ill, or has a mental disability, please call the Pistol License Bureau as soon as possible. Do not touch any firearms; leave them where they are and wait for the bureau to help you.
