The law for selling your vehicle is common law. You can agree the terms with the other party verbally or in writing. As a seller, you could put a sign on your car saying 'sold as seen, no warranty given or implied' and take cash from the first buyer. This would be a legal agreement. However, this could cause problems later if the buyer has a complaint and claims that you did not tell them something important. The AA suggests that you use a written agreement and provides a free sample. However, we think that the AA version and many other free versions online are not detailed enough to document the sale properly. This document is a comprehensive used car selling agreement form that protects both the seller and the buyer from any claims about the condition of the vehicle. It includes warranties, details of the vehicle and the parties, payment method, transfer of ownership, and DVLA registration. This form is suitable for private sales or business-to-business sales, but not for sales by professional dealers to consumers, as they have different legal rights and may need credit arrangements. To use this form, fill in as much information as possible in advance (the template is in Word format) and print two copies. Sign both copies in front of the other party and keep one as proof of sale. Make sure the payment and the ownership transfer happen at the same time. If you want to sell or buy a used car privately, you need a **used car selling agreement form**. This is a document that records the details of the transaction and protects both parties from potential disputes.

You also cannot use a 'sold as seen' receipt to avoid responsibility if the car is not roadworthy. The law says - you cannot sell a car that is not roadworthy. Get a car seller's contract (PDF) If you are selling a car,
